Subject: THE INTERNATIONAL NEED FOR A FRAUD FREE VOTING SYSTEM (FFVS)

The need for a FRAUD FREE VOTING system is many years overdue. I am involved, and soon to be a director in a highly reputable technology company, and after much discussion going on with the developers, we soon will be ready to start developing once we secured one deal with one country who would then be a partner in the international roll-out of this FFVS.

We have contacts into more than 50+ countries and many were spoken to and are waiting for this system. The team, however, chose Papua New Guinea (PNG) because of my origin, trust and respect they have, and especially for some of the firebrand leaders we have both old and new. My association with them was through Global Reward Program (GRP) now International Reward Program (IRP) and that has resulted in me also wanting to see PNG get patent over the E-Voting System permanently so that as a country can generate millions of kina from other countries around the world .

Let's get down further to understand what electoral fraud, sometimes referred to as election fraud, election manipulation or vote rigging is? Election fraud is an act of illegal interference with the process of an election either by increasing the vote share of the favored candidate, depressing the vote share of the rival candidates, or both. What exactly constitutes electoral fraud varies from country to country.

Many kinds of election fraud are outlawed in electoral legislation, but others are in violation of general laws, such as those banning assault, harassment or libel. Although technically the term "electoral fraud" covers only those acts which are illegal, the term is sometimes used to describe acts which are legal, but considered morally unacceptable, outside the spirit of an election or in violation of the principles of democracy.

Some elections containing only one candidate, while few are sometimes classified as electoral fraud, although they may comply with the law and are presented more as referendums.

In national elections, successful electoral fraud can have the effect of a coup d'etat or corruption of democracy. In a narrow election a small amount of fraud may be enough to change the result. Even if the outcome is not affected, the revelation of fraud can reduce voters' confidence in democracy.

The following are the common types of alleged electoral fraud:

· Ballot stuffing: Casting illegal votes or submitting more than one ballot per voter.

	Votes cast in the names of deceased people. The name of a deceased person remains on a state's official list of registered voters and a living person fraudulently casts a ballot in that name.
•	Felon vote fraud: The casting of a ballot by a person convicted of a felony who is not eligible to vote as a result of the conviction.
•	Voter suppression: A variety of tactics aimed at lowering or suppressing the number of voters who might otherwise vote in a particular election.
•	Voter registration fraud: Filling out and submitting a voter registration card for a fictional person, or filling out a voter registration card with the name of a real person but without that person's consent and forging his or her signature on the card.
•	Voter impersonation: A person claims to be someone else when casting a vote.

Vote-buying: Agreements between voters and others to buy and sell votes, such as a candidate paying voters to

· Fraud by election officials: Manipulation of ballots by officials administering the election, such as tossing out ballots

Absentee ballot vote fraud: A person attempts to fill out and turn in an absentee ballot containing false information.
 For example, this can occur when a person attempts to fill out and turn in an absentee ballot with the name of a false or non-existent voter. The term can extend to manipulation, deception, or intimidation of absentee voters.

The system we are proposing has the following as basics and much can be added after discussions to accommodate all

1. The ability to capture all relevant information into one central database including personal details, finger prints, retina

3. All voting to be done through a finger printing system from around 5000 voting points where the finger print machines

4. The system must include all forms of voting such as from National to Regional, Districts, Local Level Government

the needs of the PNG Government. The system to be developed will include, amongst others are as followings:

2. System must have the ability for citizens to go and alter physical addresses and other relevant information.

The highest form of security must be included and, in every way, what will be presented to us must be a program that will be 100% secure and free of all forms of fraud as PNG, and many other countries experience. We will detailed a financial model and request for a partnership deal with the Government of PNG. The program will be bought by the Government of PNG and the PNG Government will appoint our national team to take this program to many other countries of the world.

PNG will be seen as the initiator of the Fraud Free Voting System (FFVS).

A package deal will be presented to the PNG Government in which the Government will be a shareholder and partner in the roll out of the FFVS to other countries in the world.
